## Purpose/Introduction

Legal issues between members of Spirit Haven Inc. are not Spirit Haven Inc. Business. Spirit Haven shall not be a party to any legal action against any person, nor a defendant, nor a called witness against any person in any legal action of this nature as of August 14, 2006. Spirit Haven will refer any attempt by any party to involve Spirit Haven or its Officers in any actions to our corporate attorney for response.

## Policy Content

Spirit Haven resources or intellectual properties are the property of Spirit Haven, the organization, and are not to be used to further the objectives of any side of any legal action toward anyone without the express permission of the Spirit Haven Board of Directors and corporate attorney.

As of the date of adoption of this policy, the Spirit Haven Board of Directors has no such knowledge of any such violation or misuse of Spirit Haven intellectual or other properties. This policy is made by the Spirit Haven Board to make the position clear on any issues regarding Spirit Haven intellectual properties (including documents, email, or any other media or form of communication). Any attempt or action to release ANY Spirit Haven information to any source for use in any action whether for or against Spirit Haven or to be used as a support for any legal action against another will be considered a violation of the fiduciary duty of a corporate office, unless approved by the Spirit Haven attorney and the Spirit Haven Board of Directors and will be referred to the appropriate avenue for corporate or legal response. Any use of intellectual property or financial records retained by any party after their term of office are still the property of Spirit Haven and use of any records not released by the Spirit Haven Board of Directors or those of public record or in a public forum will be considered a legal violation of intellectual property rights and shall be dealt with accordingly by the Spirit Haven Board of Directors.

Any outside action involving a Director or Officer that interferes/harms or intends to harm/interfere, whether intentional or not, any Spirit Haven operation or events may be considered a violation of the oath of office, violation of fiduciary duty and/or violation of the Officer's responsibility or any combination thereof to Spirit Haven Inc., a 501(c)(3) organization.
