Purpose/Introduction

Spirit Haven holds events of many types and varieties on the premises of Spirit Haven Ranch (SHR). Certain activities, such as the Beltane and Samhain Festivals, and events which are held by third parties reserving SHR (Reserved Events) may have their own sets of rules for attendance. This document outlines the parameters for all other activities held at SHR by Spirit Haven, collectively referred to as “Spirit Haven Activities”.

Policy Content

- A. Attendance at Spirit Haven Activities may be open to members and/or non-members of Spirit Haven, at the discretion of the Board.
- B. All persons in attendance at Spirit Haven Activities are required to sign in with the available member of the Board, the SHR Manager, or an explicitly appointed representative.
- C. All persons will, upon signing in, agree to follow the Principles of Spirit Haven.
- D. In the event of an accident or issue violating State or Federal Law, or the Principles of Spirit Haven, an Incident Report shall be created by all parties involved.
- E. The SHR Manager shall include all Incident Reports with an After-Action Report to the Board following every Spirit Haven Activity.
- F. Engaging in any of the following behaviors while in attendance at a Spirit Haven Activity may result in any individual or group being immediately being asked to leave/vacate the premises, regardless whether they are members or non-members of Spirit Haven:
 - 1. Engaging in or directly encouraging another to engage in physical violence against another individual.
 - 2. Distribution of elitist/hate literature.

Board Policy

3. Sexual misconduct/coercion.
 4. Reckless endangerment of a minor.
 5. Knowingly, by action or inaction, engaging in behavior putting the safety of Attendees/Spirit Haven membership as a whole or any individual(s) at risk.
 6. Distribution of controlled substances, as defined by State and Federal Law.
 7. Violating the Principles of Spirit Haven.
- G. In the absence of any members of the Board, the SHR Manager may *only* institute removal of any member or non-member of Spirit Haven from a Spirit Haven Activity when Spirit Haven membership or property is endangered, or if the behavior is in violation of State or Federal Law. The SHR Manager must contact the Board before beginning any removal process.

The Spirit Haven Board of Directors retains the sole authority to bar any member or non-member from attending any consecutive or future Spirit Haven Activity.
